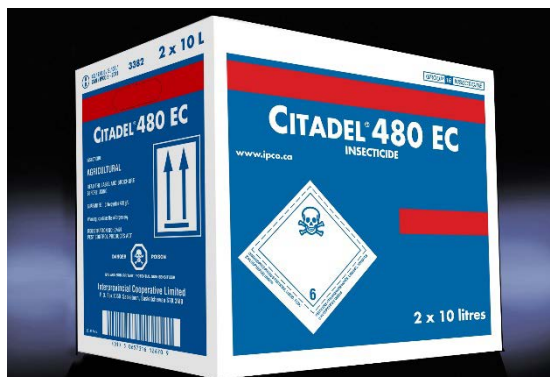


Grasshopper & Diamond Back Moth Control in Canola - CITADEL® 480 EC

Situation:

Grasshoppers and Diamondback Moths have been reported at economic threshold levels in several areas across the prairie provinces.

Solution:

Protect your canola yield and grade by using **Citadel 480 EC** available at your local retailer. **Citadel 480 EC** is a general purpose insecticide that will defend your crop from these yield and quality robbing pests. **Citadel 480 EC** can be applied by ground or air, and provides effective control of Diamondback Moths, grasshoppers and other insect pests in canola.

Guidelines for Diamondback Moth Control with Citadel 480 EC

- **Scout fields** at least twice per week. Refer to the Canola Council of Canada website for insect identification.
- **Economic Threshold** – Consider Citadel 480 EC application when 20 – 30 larvae/0.1 m² are present at the advanced pod stage. This is 2-3 larvae/plant where plant population is 100 plants/m²
- **Application:**
 - Ground: Apply 0.4 – 0.6 L of product in 40 – 80 L of water/Acre
 - Water volume for aerial application is 16 L of water/Acre
 - Use higher rates and water volumes for heavier insect infestations
 - Spray in the evening to reduce risk to pollinators and when insects are more active
