Casual Production Workers, under the guidance of the Line Leaders and Shift Supervisors, are responsible for contributing to safe, quality, and efficient packaging processes in order to meet the established production standards. Duties include but are not limited to: manual handling of packaging materials, operating packaging equipment, general cleaning and housekeeping, performing quality inspections throughout the entire packaging process, ensuring equipment is operating properly, reporting any issues to the Line Leader or Supervisor, following all health and safety requirements including wearing personal PPE, following all company policies and procedures and other company programs such as COVID-19 guidelines, respectful workplace and contamination prevention, meeting expectations of the position, and performing all other duties as assigned.
